\$2,500 request to support agency activities like volunteer referrals and placement, as well as training.
 - 2. Resources for Community Living – Fred Stupen presented info.
\$4,000 request to support in-home services to individuals with developmental and/or physical disabilities.
 - 3. Little City Foundation – Lori Palmer Kane presented info.
\$5,000 request to support the employment program which assists individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities obtain employment.
 - 4. Center for Enriched Living – Randi Frank presented info.

- \$25,000 request to support the REACH adult day program, satellite programming, evening programs and excursions for individuals with developmental disabilities.
5. Special Leisure Services Foundation (Fundraising arm of NWSRA) – Cathy Splett presented info. \$2,000 to help purchase sensory kits for individuals with developmental disabilities.
 6. Clearbrook Center – Tina Yurik presented info. \$35,000 to support the residential program, day services, and child therapy program for individuals with developmental disabilities.
 7. Clearbrook Partners in Adult Learning – Paul Jochim presented info. \$1,500 to support a program offering classroom and community-based learning, volunteer, and recreational experiences to people with disabilities.
 8. Clearbrook “Take a Break” Respite – Tina Yurik presented info. \$2,500 to support the volunteer program that matches trained volunteers with families who have young children with developmental delays and provides a respite for them.
