The Township of Schaumburg Board of Trustees has closely followed the ongoing developments with the COVID-19 (coronavirus) outbreak. In an effort to follow the guidelines set by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), the Board has decided to take additional precautions until further notice. Including:

- The food pantry will remain OPEN under a modified drive-through capacity. Clients can still choose from a list of grocery items, which staff will package and deliver to clients in their cars in the parking lot. Clients should call to schedule a drive-through appointment with the pantry at 847-884-0030. Emergency pre-packed bags will also be available. All clients who have already made traditional pantry appointments will be contacted by Welfare Services staff. The pantry will continue to operate during regular business hours - Monday-Friday from 9-4pm. Homebound residents should contact any of our departments regarding food assistance.
- The Township Transportation Services will only provide rides for dialysis appointments. Critical medical appointments will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- The Township will suspend all in-person appointments and will begin conducting all appointments via phone or video for Senior, Disability and Welfare Services as well as the Assessor's Office. Senior, Disability and Welfare Services will continue making wellness checks during this health emergency. Urgent, in-person appointments will be made on a case-by-case basis with the appropriate staff person.
- The Township will suspend passport and notary services. We are still available to assist with passport questions and can help with adult renewals over the phone at 847-285-4561.
- The Township will continue to suspend all group activities, following guidelines from the CDC, IDPH and the Illinois Department on Aging.

We remain committed to serving the community during these challenging times and will regularly assess the situation.
