### LIHEAP Available October 1

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program will begin October 1, 2019. The program provides assistance toward Nicor Gas and/or ComEd accounts. In order to apply October 1, there must be a person over the age of sixty or with a Social Security approved disability in the home. Starting November 1, households with a child under the age of six or with a disconnect notice may apply. December 1 is when all income-eligible households may apply. Call 847-884-0030 for documents and to make an appointment.

### Medicare Part C/D Annual Enrollment 10/15-12/7

The Medicare Part C and D Annual Enrollment Period is October 15—December 7. This is the annual period when you can review, change, join, or cancel your Part C (Advantage) or Part D plans. Senior Services staff are trained to assist you in evaluating options through the Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP). SHIP Counselors provide free, unbiased Medicare counseling.

Contact Senior Services after September 23 to schedule an appointment during open enrollment. You will need to bring your Medicare card and a complete list of medications including dosage and frequency. New this year: you will have to create an online account with [mymedicare.gov](http://mymedicare.gov) for personalized options. You can do this on your own in advance, or staff can assist. We are pleased to announce that there will also be limited evening hours by appointment. Contact 847-884-0030 for more information.

## SHIP Trained Staff Ready to Help

The Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) is a free counseling service to help people with Medicare. Township staff are trained in SHIP and available to help explain benefits, troubleshoot issues, or clarify information. Appointments are required and can be made by calling 847-884-0030.

SHIP is sponsored by the Illinois Department on Aging. Our counselors are happy to help deal with complex issues and questions related to health insurance. SHIP does not affiliate with any insurance company and does not sell or solicit any type of insurance. For those who have Medicare AND Medicaid, we can also help navigate the MMAI program.

## Telephone Check In Program

Between the Polar Vortex, tornadoes, and extreme heat, the weather in our area is unpredictable to say the least. We are creating a new list of people in our community who would like to be contacted in case of emergency or extreme weather. In the event of extreme weather or other situation, staff or volunteers would reach out and touch base with the resident. Township staff will then work with other providers or departments to establish services, if needed. ## Free Energy Assistance Programs

Nicor recently announced a new program called "energySMART." The energySMART program will send kits of easy, energy-saving products to Nicor customers at no charge. The easy-to-use kits will help you save money and reduce energy usage!

There is no income requirement, but eligible households must have a Nicor account. Kits will be mailed directly to homes within 4-5 weeks. Please call us at 847-884-0030 with any questions or to make an appointment to sign up.

ComEd customers may qualify for a new pilot program called "Savings for Income Eligible Seniors." A technician will install energy efficiency products at no charge to eligible customers.

To qualify, you must have ComEd service, be 60 and older, reside in suburban Cook County, and meet income guidelines. The income limit for a single family household is \$47,400. If you have questions or would like an appointment, call 847-884-0030.

## RTA Reduced Fare and Free Ride Transit Program

Did you know that there are two programs to assist older adults and persons with disabilities access public transportation? The Regional Transportation Authority provides the "Reduced Fare" and "Free Ride" transit programs.

To qualify for the reduced fare program, you simply need to be over the age of 65. To qualify for the "Free Ride" transit pass, you must meet "Benefit Access" eligibility guidelines (see below).

Residents are welcome to apply for either transit pass at the Township. You will need to bring a photo ID, completed application (available in Senior Services), and 2"x2" picture. We are able to take your picture for a \$2 suggested donation. There is no other fee to apply.

## Holiday Adoptions

The winter season is quickly approaching! If you are in need this holiday season, we invite you to apply for our holiday Adopt-A-Senior program. Adopt-A-Senior provides specialized care packages from community donations. To qualify, your income needs to be less than \$1,561 for a single household and \$2,114 for a two-person household. Special circumstances will also be considered.

To apply, you must meet with a staff member between October 1 and October 25. We cannot guarantee that all requests will be fulfilled. Preference will be given to first-time applicants. For more details or for an appointment, call 847-884-0030.

## Benefit Access Program

The Benefit Access Program is a program available to Illinois residents who meet income guidelines. Eligible applicants must also be over the age of 65 or 16 and older with a disability. To qualify, a single household must have gross income from the previous tax year less than \$27,610; for a two-person household, the limit is \$36,635.

Benefit Access provides two benefits—a discount off the annual license plate registration fee and eligibility for the Free Ride Transit Pass which provides free transportation on all public, fixed route transportation. To see if you qualify or to schedule an appointment, call 847-884-0030.
